Elite International School participated in the 8th GASNA competition for the academic year 2021-2022, in 3 competition categories.

1st Category: KG – 4th

These students performed a skit titled 'Qatar Believed! Achieved! Reached the Peak!', outlining the timeline of the discovery of oil in the Dukhan oil field and the North Field East (NFE) - the world's largest-ever liquified natural gas (LNG) project. The skit ended by portraying the Qatar's National Vision of 2030 in which Qatar becomes an advanced society capable of sustaining its development and providing a high standard of living for its people.



2nd Category: 5th and 6th

The students of 6A, namely Rashid Safar Rashid Al Shafi, Khaled Hussam Al Shehneh, Chanim Mohammed Al Hazaa, Mohamad Hussein Alayan were selected based on the ideas and themes discussed during the selection rounds.

The model was titled, 'A Quest: From Black Gold to Vision 2030!' The model portrayed delivering natural gas from oil wells to consumers. The different layers depicted the story of formation of oil from microscopic plants and animals living in the ocean millions of years ago.



3rd Category: 7th – 9th

Model Title: Transition from Energy of Gas to Energy of Youth

The students of 7A, Shaikha Hamad Al Shareef and Misk Mazen Mahmoud, recreated the model of Al-Thumama Stadium Qatar, successfully showing the relevance to oil and gas industry of Qatar.





ENGLISH DEPARTMENT

In celebration of the holy month of Ramadan and the Garangao Festival in April, Grade 5 students composed short personal narratives about their Ramadan and Garangao experiences. They recounted various activities such as fasting and observance of daily prayers. Students also created short text-to-text write-ups, focused on community service and volunteering, and related it with Qatar National Identity, whereas Grade 6 students composed text-to-world written outputs by comparing the Qatar’s educational system with that of the settings of two literary texts they have studied in class. Themes such as racial and gender equality emerged from class discussion and were connected to Qatar National Identity.



Students dressed up in beautiful and colorful traditional clothes when they visited other classes to collect sweets and shared what Garangao means to them. Meanwhile, Grade 2 and 3 students researched and drew pictures of their favorite animals so they could write fun facts about them! Students were also able to 'Listen, Reflect, and Illustrate' after they listened to a story and identified its integral elements.



ELITE SCIENTISTS

Activities conducted in Grades 1-7 provided students with opportunities to apply important unit concepts and develop their scientific skills through hands-on experiments and fun projects. Students learned to write, speak, and behave as real scientists, helping them design and pursue their own investigations in the future.

Each Process Activity included a purpose, background information, a materials list, a data sheet, and several questions to help students develop their hypotheses and draw conclusions.



SST/Q.H. DEPARTMENT

Do you want to find interesting information about different cultures and civilizations? In the Social Studies and Qatar History department, young historians of EIS dived into ancient cultures to learn more about the past. Grade 2 students drew a mosque to show that Muslims around the world go for daily prayers, whereas Grade 1 students learned how folktales are closely related to different cultures.

Throughout the celebration of World Wildlife Day and Labor Day, students created advocacy posters focusing on the theme 'Caring for the Environment', illustrating various methods undertaken by the State of Qatar to care for natural resources.

They reason out, solve problems, and communicate their ideas by making estimates, persevering throughout difficult questions, and justifying their process. 
ICT



Ignorance is bliss, but facing the truth and changing for the better truly allows us to stop and smell the roses that have been there throughout this journey!






